New double-layer socks keep feet dry

A new line of socks that stays up to 25 times drier than other socks is now available.

Drymax Sports socks have been designed with two different fiber technologies that are interwoven to form a dual-layer sock.

“Moisture won’t adhere to the inner (super hydrophobic) fiber terry loops, which allow them to squeegee sweat off the skin into the outer (hydrophilic) moisture-attracting fiber layer. This advanced design creates a self-contained moisture removal system, keeping feet dry and comfortable in all types of footwear in cold, hot and wet conditions,” the company says.

Drymax socks come in five sizes compared with the usual three, and have protective padding in four densities (low, medium, medium+ and high), top and bottom air vents and a MicroZap antimicrobial additive that is infused into the socks for long-term odor control.

“I am very interested in recommending these socks to my patients with hyperhidrosis and recurrent inflammatory tinea pedis. I believe that they may be a great addition to our armamentarium for controlling these chronic conditions and for decreasing the number of recurrent infections,” says Elena Martinho, M.D., a fellow of the American Academy of Dermatology, and in private practice in Templeton, Calif.
